

Wheel Measurer Instructions

1. Measure Track Width of each Competitor
 - a. Place cones (flat side in) against widest part of the wheels with the carriage at a full halt. (BACK wheels for a 4-wheeled carriage – does not matter if front wheels are wider.)
 - b. Ask the competitor to drive forward and be sure they do not “nudge” the cones in the process – if they do have them halt again and redo the previous step.
 - c. Measure between the cones to determine the Track Width in centimeters, using your measuring stick.

2. Record the Track Width on forms provided.

For Laurels: Record Competitor Number and Track Width on the Blank Wheel Measurement Form

For TBP: Find the Competitors Number on the “Cones Width by Competitor” Form

- a. Record the Track Width in centimeters in the Measurement Column
 - b. Add the Track Width to the “Clearance” amount and record the Total in the Cones Width column.
 - c. Write the Total on the competitor card, hand to competitor and tell them to give card to the Cones In Gate when they check in at the Cones Ring.
3. If the Competitor is on the “Advanced” list, verify that the Track Width is greater than or equal to the minimum required for their class. If the Track Width is less than the minimum, redo the measurement. If still less, inform the competitor and immediately call for the TD. **If this is Cones Day, the class cannot be placed until the TD or Judge makes a ruling!**
4. If this is Cones Day, send the competitor on to the “Bit Check” station if there is one.
